We have started to make our plans for the Zandvoort weekend and thought that you may be interested in the following to help you make yours. The current plan for the timetable is as follows but further details will follow once they have been finalised

Testing; as this is the first time we have been to Zandvoort as a championship as well as to Europe we are conscious of costs and your time. Therefore for this round only (rounds 3 & 4) there will be a total testing ban at this circuit. For clarification this means that any driver entered for these 2 rounds **must not** have driven in any form of vehicle or format this year at this circuit

Entry Fee; the entry fee for this round will include the free practise on Friday morning and will be £600
