- **Final Instructions; Rounds 1 & 2 Oulton Park**

Attached are the final instructions for the opening rounds at Oulton Park together with the current timetable for the weekend. The main points are as follows;

- Access to the paddock will be from 1800 on Thursday 20 March. If you wish to leave any vehicles on site before this you are able to park them in the competitor's car park adjacent to the paddock.
- Engines must not be run before 0800 and after 1830
- Any drivers that have not raced at Oulton Park before must collect an instruction sheet from race administration.

1350 - 1410 Qualifying
1500 Mandatory drivers briefing in the Volkswagen Race Centre

Sunday 23 March

Circuit is closed

Monday 24 March

0800 onwards Breakfast will be served in the Volkswagen Race Centre
0935 Race 1
1200 – 1400 Lunch served in the Volkswagen Race Centre
1555 Race 2
1700 Prize giving in the Volkswagen Race Centre
